- A faculty of certified pre-school teachers with an average of 9-10 years of classroom teaching experience

- MCPK offers a child emergent curriculum based on Dr. Howard Gardner's Theory of Multiple Intelligences. Children engage in units of work based on their own interests
- MCPK offers an environment where children are encouraged to explore their role as members of a caring community and learn important lessons from their own experiences
- MCPK curriculum fully prepares children to enter Kindergarten
- MCPK curriculum is designed to meet the learning needs of all pre-school age children and creates an inclusive environment for children with physical, intellectual or other disabilities

The MCPK Family Support Services

- A Family Services Director who is on-site every day to assist families, children and teaching staff
- A Family Network Center that provides workshops, support groups and activities for families
- Pajama Club run (for a minimal fee) by our own staff twice a month, so that parents can go out for a few hours and know their children are in a safe place
- Referrals to community resources on education and counseling
- Ability to provide assistance to families who have children with special needs
- Working relationship with the Montclair School District Preschool Child Study Team and Developmental Learning Center to provide inclusion education for children with special needs
- Active Parent Association and parental involvement
- Financial counseling and referrals provided by Finance Director
- Crisis Intervention provided by Family Services Director
